5.0 BUSINESS ARISING:

Septic update: Had a Finance and Property Management meeting and CBCL came back with three options to be reviewed by the committee. Headlines -

• Option 1 keep existing system, , install holding tank for problem periods a new holding tank (approx. 1,500 igal) and overflow pipe from the existing septic tank would be installed to receive flow from the building during conditions when the existing disposal field is saturated

- Option 2 keep existing system, install pump chamber and overflow disposal system. A second smaller septic tank (approx. 450 igal) c/w pump would be installed next to the existing septic tank. Option 3 new system.
- Option 3 Install a new system.

HR & Events Committee - session on July 23, 30 and August 30 change to schedule to reorder the topics with Stanhope, West Covehead and Covehead Rd. All sessions at 7:30pm at Stanhope Place. July 16th is the walkathon starting at 6:30pm.

6. <u>REPORTS:</u>

6.1 <u>Chair</u>: Chair Ellis noted we have hired a new student Justin Cudmore for maintenance until August 21st. Official opening for the promenade was held with a good attendance.

Councillor Vriends ask about the history of the septic system in the community. Administrator responded with the cooperation from the Province, will compile where we can. Councillor Hemphill noted the lack of residence participation in the water and wastewater researcher. Administrator noted any input in direction or suggestions for residences is welcome. Councillor MacLauchlan noted the need for having something to leave behind to follow up.

Small Halls Small Halls Festival on June 19th (\$355 profit 165-170 attended), Official Opening of the Promenade on June 26th (\$24.99 cost approximately 30 attended) and then Canada Day July 1st (\$545 net cost approximately 350 attended)

Councillor Egan and Watts suggested more shade areas. Response is to purchase tent shelters for next year. Gas tax funding - we will have a notional allocation of approximately \$26,000 each year for five years.
