- **Dr. Sarah Stewart Clark, Ph.D. Dalhousie**, is an associate professor of shellfish aquaculture at Dalhousie University, Canada, Truro. Sarah's active research program is investigating the impacts of climate change related stressors on shellfish aquaculture species; Selected breeding programs guided by SNP data at the transcriptome level, the identification of invasive species in Atlantic Canada, and how pathogens in invasive species interact with native specie. She uses both a transcriptomic and an ecological toolbox to study marine and aquatic ecosystems.
